### **PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF DOCUMENTS**

The Government of Rwanda and Development Partners are intensifying their support to infrastructure development to reduce post-harvest loss and the high transport price. In this regards, the Government of Rwanda launched the Rwanda Feeder Roads Development Project (RFRDP) to develop agricultural marketing roads.

The RFRDP aims at improving road infrastructure by rehabilitating, upgrading and maintaining rural roads in selected districts; developing strategies for rural access and transport mobility improvement and ensuring institutional development and project management.

Towards the implementation of the FRDP, the GoR has received funding from the International Development Association (IDA) for the rehabilitation, upgrading and maintenance of selected feeder roads in Rwamagana, Gisagara, Karongi and Nyamasheke Districts. The GoR has also received Additional Financing for the rehabilitation, upgrading and maintenance of feeder roads in other six districts. These are Nyagatare and Gatsibo of Eastern Province, Nyaruguru of Southern Province, Nyabihu and Rutsiro of Western Province and Gakenke of Northern Province.

In line with the Government of Rwanda and the World Bank requirements, RFRDP has prepared the following documents for the implementation of the feeder roads development activities:
