The Government of Rwanda (GOR) has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) toward the cost of the Socio-Economic inclusion of Refugees and Host Communities Project (SEIRHCP)/Jya Mbere Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for *Rehabilitation /Upgrading and multi years maintenance of Rusozi-Mahama-Mpanga-Kabuye Road - LOT 1: Rusozi-Nyamugali-Mahama refugee camp road (14 km) in Kirehe District under Design, Build and Maintain Contract* following OPBRC.
2. The Rwanda Transport Development Agency (RTDA) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for *Rehabilitation /Upgrading and multi years maintenance of Rusozi-Mahama-Mpanga-Kabuye Road - LOT 1: Rusozi-Nyamugali-Mahama refugee camp road (14 km) in Kirehe District under Design, Build and Maintain Contract* (DBM), where the Contractor shall be responsible for the design and construction works, and three years maintenance works through Output and Performance-based road contract. The cost of the last year (Year 3) for maintenance will be funded by the GoR.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers", April 2021

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("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

4. Enquiries regarding this tender shall be sent to RTDA through e-Procurement, via www.umucyo.gov.rw in the window request for Clarification 14 days before deadline period for the submission of bids.
5. The bidding document in English may be obtained through e-Procurement, via www.umucyo.gov.rw free of charge.
6. A Non-compulsory site visit is scheduled on the date indicated in **UMUCYO e-Procurement System** and all bidders are advised to participate in. The venue for departure is Rwanda Transport Development Agency (RTDA) Headquarters, at **08h00 AM time (6:00 AM GMT)**.
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a "*Bid-Securing Declaration*," in conformity of the Form of Bid-Securing Declaration, signed in the issued tender document.
8. All Bids must be accompanied by a Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (SEA) and/or Sexual Harassment (SH) Declaration.
9. Bids must be delivered through e-Procurement System, via www.umucyo.gov.rw not later than the date indicated in UMUCYO e-Procurement System.
10. Bids will be opened automatically by the e-Procurement System, via www.umucyo.gov.rw on the date indicated in UMUCYO e-Procurement System.
