1. The Government of Rwanda (GoR) has received a grant from Nordic Development Funds (NDF), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for the Supply of Computers for Development of Climate resilient Project;
2. The Rwanda Transport Development Agency (RTDA) (hereinafter called Client) invites qualified bidders to submit their bids for the **Supply of Computers for Development of Climate resilient Project** as indicated in detail in the statement of Requirements. The participation in the tender is open on equal conditions to all specialized companies registered with trading license.
3. Tender Documents in English may be obtained from RTDA procurement office. For submission of their bids, interested bidders are required to pay a non-refundable fee of Seven Thousand Rwandan Francs (7,000 FRW) to the Rwanda Revenue Authority account in any commercial Bank operating in Rwanda.
4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from Rwanda Transport Development Agency (RTDA), via email address: [procurement@rtda.gov.rw](mailto:procurement@rtda.gov.rw) attention: Director General of RTDA and inspect the bidding documents during office hours from 07:00 to 17:00 hours Local Time at the RTDA headquarter \Procurement Office.
5. Bids must be delivered to the RTDA Procurement Office on or before 26<sup>th</sup> January 2021 at 10:00 am. Local Time (08:00 am. GMT) and must be accompanied by a bid security in a form of a reputable Bank or other financial institution Guarantee of an amount of Three Hundred Thirty Two Thousand Five Hundred (332,500Frw) Rwandan Francs or its equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the RTDA address indicated below on the same date at 10:30 am. Local Time (08:30 am. GMT). Late bids will be returned unopened.
6. The bids should be valid for **One Hundred Twenty (120) calendar days minimum** from the date of bids opening.
7. Bidding will be conducted through the procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credit & Grants by World Bank Borrowers (dated January 2011 and revised July 2014).
